If your reading and writing skills aren't ready for Level 3 course work, you'll be required to attend adult literacy classes.

To ensure your expectations match the programme, or to discuss any support you might need during your studies, please contact us.

English language

This programme has open entry, however English language requirements apply. If English isn't your first language you may be required to provide evidence of your English language skills.

Please refer to our website for relevant IELTS information. If you have no evidence of your English language skills and you're a New Zealand citizen or resident, please contact us for an assessment.

Please note:

- All pathways are offered in Christchurch
- Only the health pathway is offered in Timaru (in February)
- The first number in the course code indicates the level (eg CSCP300 is a Level 3 course)
- · Some maths courses have a pre-requisite
- Only one Level 2 course may be selected in any pathway
- All courses are 15 credits and the whole programme of four courses totals 60 credits
- Completion of the certificate does not mean automatic entry into your chosen programme. Graduates of this programme must apply and meet all requirements of their destination programme
- If your goal is a degree, you'll also need to complete the New Zealand Certificate in Study and Career Preparation Level 4
- The maximum period of time to complete the programme is two years. Extensions may be approved in some circumstances by the Head of Department

40 credits at NCEA Level 2 including 10 Level 1 literacy credits and 10 Level 1 mathematics credits, OR New Zealand Certificate in Study and Career Preparation Level 3.

Alternative

If you can demonstrate tertiary study skills (including literacy and numeracy) gained through work and/or life experience, you may be eligible for alternative entry. Literacy and numeracy assessments are available.

English language

If you have no evidence of your English language skills, and you're a New Zealand citizen or resident, please contact us for an assessment.


